Clonakilty Distillery introduces its inaugural Single Pot Still release. This whiskey was triple distilled, matured, and bottled on the Atlantic coastline in Clonakilty, capturing the essence of our coastal heritage.

Matured in Ex-Bourbon and Amontillado sherry casks, this award winning whiskey presents flavours of sweet vanilla and custard cream, complemented by notes of salted caramel and toasted nuts. These elements harmonise to deliver the perfect balance of sweetness and a full-bodied character, leaving a long, lingering sensation on the palate.

History

On May 1st, 2019 Clonakilty distilled its initial Single Pot Still spirit. Within the first year, it secured the title of the World's Best Irish Single Pot Still New Make, at the World Whiskies Awards. Now, this exceptional spirit has matured into an outstanding whiskey.

Talking Points

- Created with 100% Irish barley, both un-malted and malted.
- Extended fermentation period allows the natural yeast additional time to enrich the flavour profile.
- Triple-distilled to craft a lighter, sweeter spirit.
- Water added slowly and gradually, a method referred to as 'The Gentle Cut'.
- The whiskey was allowed to mature for as long as necessary, even if this meant the angels claimed more than their usual share. Devils
