

## DOMINIO DE ATAUTA WINERY ATTENDS PROWEIN SINGAPORE

Bodegas Dominio de Atauta is proud to announce its presence at the Prowein Singapore Fair, where it will showcase its excellent selection of Ribera del Duero wines to the Asian Market.

Dominio de Atauta is located in the northeast east of Spain, at the beginning of the Ribera del Duero appellation, only 50 km. away from the birthplace of the Duero River, at almost 3,300 feet above sea level. This is the highest and coldest part of the region.

It is a privileged area for growing vines thanks to its exceptional climate conditions, orography and great variety of soils. Moreover, it has over five centuries of winemaking tradition. "We do feel the responsibility to do our best in this unique area", says Ismael Sanz, head of viticulture in Dominio de Atauta.

"More than two decades working in the valley have allowed us to know the particularities of each of our more than 500 single-plot vineyards," says Jaime Suárez, the winery's winemaker. Considering this, each plot is vinified separately with utmost respect to the essence and nature of its grapes.

Dominio de Atauta aims to transmit through its wines the complexity and singularity of this unique valley. "Our wines show the great variety of soils in the valley, with the common characteristic of minerality coming from the calcareous bedrock present all along the valley".

"The age of our vineyards goes from 100 up to 180 years old", claims Ismael Sanz. We have hardly worked to recover some of them that had been abandoned, and we are getting back outstanding wines with an incredible singularity and a personality."

Parada de Atauta, coming from the sandy and highest soils of the valley; Dominio de Atauta, made with the best grapes from the different terroirs; the Albillo Mayor, the winery's first white wine; and the outstanding Single Vineyards Collection complete the winery's portfolio, which has been highlighted by international critics such as Wine Advocate, James Suckling, and others.
